
Pulaski County offers abundant produce at two FARMERS MARKETS, various roadside stands, Haney's Appledale Farm, Wilson's Strawberry (U-pick) and Bear Wallow Farm.



There's a CAMPING spot for you on Lake Cumberland at areas like Pulaski County Park, Fishing Creek or Waitsboro. General Burnside Island State Park offers the area's largest campground, complete with a five-lane boat launch, golf course and recreational facilities.
